

The St. Moritz Gourmet Festival will be postponed by one year

The 28th edition of the St. Moritz Gourmet Festival, under the motto “SWISS MADE”, will take place a year later, from 28th January to 5th February 2022. Then again as usual with a varied event programme.

Less than a month ago, the organisers were still confident that the St. Moritz Gourmet Festival 2021 could take place, at least on a smaller scale. The requirements to do so with extensive protective and hygienic measurements have been so far and still are in place at the ten festival partner hotels in the Upper Engadine.

At the present moment, the unpredictable framework conditions make necessary planning security impossible for a festival programme at the end of January, even for smaller enjoyable events. Unfortunately, nothing will change in the foreseeable future. This is why the 28th festival edition has been entirely postponed by a year. Under the motto “SWISS MADE”, ten Swiss star chefs as master guest chefs together with the likewise awarded local chefs of the partner hotels, will then offer exceptional culinary delights in the Upper Engadine from Friday 28th January to Saturday 5th February 2022.

“This decision has been taken mainly with the hope and the desire of offering again as usual to the festival guests and all the participants in 2022, unlimited pleasure at our cult festival with its varied enjoyment programme”, explains Martin Scherer, President of the St. Moritz Gourmet Festival association.

One thing is already clear: even though we have to renounce to the St. Moritz Gourmet Festival in the coming year, carefree and eventful stays in the partner hotels with their numerous advantages will also be possible during this winter season. A journey to the Engadine remains worthwhile!
