Change of guest chefs - new entry with Stéphane Décotterd

Even in the life of a top chef, joyful upcoming family events can thwart career plans. This is also true for Christian Kuchler, who will not be able to take part in the St. Moritz Gourmet Festival at the end of January 2021 as a guest chef from the Taverne zum Schäfli after all. Top chef **Stéphane Décotterd** from Le Pont de Brent above Montreux, awarded 18 GaultMillau points and two Michelin stars, will now complete the top-class line-up of the ten Swiss guest chefs at the festival.

For reasons of time availability, guest chef Markus Arnold from the Steinhalle in Bern (GaultMillau "POP of the year 2021", 16 GaultMillau points, 1 Michelin star) is swapping his festival partner hotel with the addition to the line-up. Markus Arnold will now delight the festival guests at the Hotel Nira Alpina in Silvaplana together with Executive Chef Dariusz Durdyn from 29th January to 2nd February 2021. Stéphane Décotterd will offer supreme culinary delicacies from 2nd to 6th February 2021, as the guest chef of Executive Chef Matthias Schmidberger at the Grand Hotel des Bains Kempinski in St. Moritz instead.
